SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1521, L.D. 1834,
Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Minimum Wage to
\$2.30 an Hour."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting
at the end, before the period, the following:


'Until January 1, 1976 and Thereafter to \$2.35
an Hour'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after
the words "per hour" in the 8th line (7th line
in L.D.) the underlined words, abbreviation
and figures 'and, beginning January 1, 1976,
at the rate of less than \$2.35 per hour'; and
by striking out in the 12th line (10th line
in L.D.) the underlined figure "\$2.30" and
inserting in place thereof the underlined figure
'\$2.35'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the minimum
wage shall be \$2.35 per hour beginning January
1, 1976, and provides that when the federal
minimum wage increases above \$2.35, the state
minimum wage shall increase also, up to the
amount of \$3 per hour.
