COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1508, L.D. 1839, Resolve, to Reimburse Michael Forrester of Arundel for Loss of Livestock Destroyed by Dogs.

Amend said Resolve by striking out everything after the title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Michael Forrester; reimbursed. Resolved:  
That there is appropriated from the General Fund to Michael Forrester of Arundel the sum of \$150 as full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of 2 goats destroyed by dogs.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the amount of the claim to be allowed from \$200 to \$150.
