HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 498, L.D. 1845,  
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Power of the Lewiston  
Parking District to Mortgage Certain Properties and  
Permitting the Taxation of Real Property of the  
District Which is Not Used for Parking."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 3  
the following:

'Sec. 4. P&SL 1957, c. 2, §19 is enacted  
to read:

Sec. 19. Expenditures of \$25,000 or more. The  
district shall not make any one expenditure of funds  
of \$25,000 or more unless that expenditure has  
been approved by both the Planning Board of the  
City of Lewiston and by the City Council of the  
City of Lewiston.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires the approval of the  
Planning Board of the City of Lewiston and of the  
City Council of the City of Lewiston before the  
district may make any one expenditure of \$25,000  
or more.
