AN ACT Relating to Reciprocal and Apportioned Registration of Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 2243-A is enacted to read:

§ 2243-A. Reciprocal and apportioned registrations

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Title, the Secretary of State, in concurrence with the Commissioner of Transportation, is authorized to enter into reciprocal agreements or plans on behalf of the State of Maine with the appropriate authorities of any of the states of the United States, the District of Columbia or any state or province of any country providing for the registration of vehicles on any apportionment or allocation basis and may, in the exercise of this authority, enter into and become a member of the International Registration Plan.

The Secretary of State is further authorized to provide for the registration of a fleet of vehicles operated by a nonresident owner on an apportionment or allocation basis where such vehicles are regularly being operated between points without the State to points within the State.

For purposes of this section, a fleet shall mean one or more vehicles.

FISCAL NOTE

The New England Regional Conference of October 1974 indicated that participation by the State of Maine in the International Registration Plan would bring an annual revenue increase of \$200,000.
