## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 107TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 503, L.D. 1859, Bill,

"AN ACT to Provide for Full-time Administrative Officers in the
Senate and House of Representatives."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph after the amending clause of section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The President of the Senate may authorize either the
Secretary of the Senate or the Assistant Secretary of the Senate
to serve on a full-time basis when the Legislature is not in
regular or special session at a salary of \$250 per week.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph before the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Speaker of the House of Representatives may authorize
either the Clerk of the House of Representatives or the Assistant
Clerk of the House of Representatives to serve on a full-time
basis when the Legislature is not in regular or special session
at a salary of \$250 per week.'
