HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1549, L.D. 1866,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Possession of Firearms
During the Open Season on Deer."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the last
2 lines before the Statement of Fact (same in L.D.)
the underlined words "from a boat or blind in
conjunction with waterfowl decoys".
