SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1550, L.D. 1867,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Sales Tax Interest and  
Penalties."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the  
last 4 lines (same in L.D.) of section 1 and insert-  
ing in place thereof the following:


'Every person incurring a use tax liability of \$25,  
or sales tax liability of any amount in one calendar  
month, shall pay a penalty of \$1 or 2% of tax  
liability, whichever is greater, if he shall omit  
to report or pay the same at or before the time  
required.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to reduce  
the percent of tax liability to be paid as a  
penalty to equalize the options.
