COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 1564, L.D. 1872, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Town of St. George to Hold a Special Town Meeting in May, 1975, to Vote on Certain Local Option Questions Concerning the Sale of Liquor."

Amend said Bill in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) after the enacting clause by striking out the word "questions" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'question'

Further amend said Bill in the 6th and 7th lines (5th and 6th lines in L.D.) after the enacting clause by striking out everything after the word "questions"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Shall licenses be granted in this town for the sale herein of liquor to be consumed on the premises? (Class A restaurants)'

Further amend said Bill by in the last sentence of the by striking out last paragraph before the emergency clause/everything after the words "the same validity as" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'if the question were properly voted on under the provisions of Title 28, section 101.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the local option question to be voted on by the Town of St. George.
