HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1587, L.D. 1883,  
RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to  
Provide for Reduction of the Number of Representatives in  
1985, to Establish the Number of Senators at Thirty-three  
in 1985 and to Change the Date of Convening of the Legislature.

Amend said Resolution in the title by striking out  
the words "Thirty-three" and inserting in place thereof the  
words 'Fifty-five'

Further amend said Resolution in that part relating  
to the Constitution, Art. IV, Pt. 2, §1 by striking out in  
the 9th line (8th line in L.D.) by striking out the  
underlined words "thirty-three" and inserting in place  
thereof the underlined words 'fifty-five'

Further amend said Resolution by striking out in the  
next to the last line of the 3rd paragraph from the end  
(same in L.D.) the figure "33" and inserting in place thereof  
the figure '55'

The purpose of this Amendment is to establish the  
number of Senators at 55 in 1985.
