COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1622, L.D. 1897, Bill,
"AN ACT to Create the Commission on Education Finance."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Membership. The commission shall be comprised
of 15 members as follows: Seven members from the Legislature,
3 to be selected by the President of the Senate and 4 to be
selected by the Speaker of the House, the Commissioner of
Educational and Cultural Services and 7 members from the
general public to be selected by the Governor.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the membership of the commission
to provide for 7 Legislators, the Commissioner of Educational
and Cultural Services and 7 members of the public.
