HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1622, L.D. 1897, Bill,
"AN ACT to Create the Commission on Education Finance."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Membership. The commission shall be comprised of 18 members as follows: One member of the Joint Legislative Committee on Education; one member of the Joint Legislative Committee on Appropriations; one member of the Joint Legislative Committee on Taxation; one superintendent of schools; one member representing the Maine Municipal Association; one member representing the Maine Teachers' Association; the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services; the Chairman of the State Board of Education; one member from the Legislative Council; and 9 members from the general public.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 2 of section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2. State-wide organization. The superintendent, the representatives of the Maine Municipal Association and the Maine Teachers' Association shall be selected by the state-wide organizations which they represent; and'

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the number of public members on the commission.
