# STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

## AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Jury Commissioners and County Officers in the Several Counties of the State.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until go days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to adjust salaries of jury commissioners and county officers; and

Whereas, such adjustments are needed at the earliest possible moment to meet the ever-increasing costs of living; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 14 MRSA § 1252, first ¶, those parts relating to the jury commissioners of Lincoln and Somerset Counties, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 724, § 1, are further amended to read:
