HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 546, L.D. 1909, Bill,  
"AN ACT Making Current Service Appropriations from the General Fund

Amend said Bill in section 18 by striking out under the  
caption "DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY" the following:

"0293 Public Safety --Liquor

Enforcement.....3-482

Positions	(22)	(22)
Personal Services	244,365	244,847
All Other	66,757	66,757
Capital Expenditures	24,029	23,127"

Further amend said Bill in section 18 by striking out the  
last line under the caption "DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY"  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Total Current Services            2,241,472        2,231,199'

Further amend said Bill by amending the last line of  
section 18 as to the "Total Appropriations" to reflect the purpose  
of this amendment.

\$669,882 in unnecessary funds.
