SENATE AMENDMENT'B "to S.P. 549, L.D. 1913, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Office of Energy Resources."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the first paragraph of that part designated "§5006." of section 3 the following underlined sentences:

The Office of Energy Resources shall be the designated state agency to handle all energy matters within the State which are not the specific responsibility of another state agency under the provisions of federal or state law, and authority is conferred all energy funds, on the director of such office to accept, use and administer / including federal, state and private funds, in accordance with established budgetary procedures which become available pursuant to this Act. The director may receive on behalf of the Office of Energy Resources or on behalf of the State any grants or gifts and may accept them.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to designate the Office of Energy Resources as the state agency to receive all funds concerning energy and to remove unnecessary appropriation of funds from the bill.
