
SENATE AMENDMENT " D" to S.P. 549, L.D. 1913, Bill,  
"AN ACT Concerning the Office of Energy Resources."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated  
"§5004." by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'2. Qualifications. The Director of the Office of  
Energy Resources shall have a background in engineering,  
economics, energy research or the administration of energy  
programs and shall be qualified to evaluate energy conservation  
or development proposals in terms of technical and economic  
feasibility.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove underlying  
restrictive language on qualifications of the Director of the  
office of Energy Resources.
