HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1664, L.D. 1917, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise An Act Relating to Property Taxation which was Enacted by the 106th Legislature."

Amend said Bill in section 13 in that part designated "§327." by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2. Maximum rating of assessment. A maximum rating of assessment quality of 30 by 1977 and a maximum rating of assessment quality of 25 by 1978 and thereafter.'

This amendment permits the assessors greater leeway in determining assessments.
