SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1676,  
L.D. 1923, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Licensing of Sternmen on  
Lobster and Crab Fishing Boats."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of paragraph  
B of subsection 1 of that part designated "§4404-A." and inserting  
in place thereof the following:


'B. Sternman. Any person performing a service on a  
lobster boat engaged in lobster fishing other than  
the lobster boat operator shall be a sternman.'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting at the end of the  
1st paragraph  
of subsection 2 of that part designated "§4404-A." the  
following underlined words 'unless licensed under section 4404,  
subsection 7'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the  
underlined word "must" in the 8th line of subsection 2 of that  
part designated "§4404-A." the underlined words 'be physically  
present on the boat on which the sternman is working and must'

House Amendment "A".
