HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1677, L.D. 1924, Bill, "AN ACT
Establishing Educational Requirements for Licensing of Real
Estate Brokers."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting in the first
sentence, after the underlined words "specializing in" the
following underlined words: 'residential or commercial'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by inserting a new
sentence after the 3rd sentence of that part designated "§4115-B."
to read as follows:

'The study pertaining to the real estate profession shall be
deemed to include courses in residential or commercial real
estate.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow brokers who deal
in commercial real estate to take courses appropriate to their
field of endeavor.
