SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1697, L.D. 1931, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 42 the following:

'Sec. 42-A. 21 MRSA 1259, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

7. Candidate. A candidate or his designee shall be permitted within the guardrail to observe the counting of absentee ballots for any election in which he is a candidate. At no time shall anyone interfere with a candidate's view of absentee ballots being counted.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment ensures a candidate a clear view of the absentee ballot counting process.
