HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1698, L.D. 1932, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Maine No-fault Motor Vehicle Insurance
Reform."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§2959." by inserting in the 3rd line of subsection 1 (same
in L.D.) before the underlined words "Social Security" the
underlined
following/words and punctuation: 'a nonprofit hospital or
medical service organization, a health insurance policy,'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include as a
subtractable benefit the proceeds or advantages which an
injured person would receive as a result of payments by a
health insurance company or a nonprofit hospital or medical
service organization. This amendment would not permit a no-
fault insurer to pay medical or hospital expenses which had
already been paid by another source. By eliminating such
duplicate coverage, a concomitant reduction in the no-fault
premium cost should be realized.
