HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1700,

J.D. 1933, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Board of Environmental

Protection to Regulate the Anchorage of Tankers in Casco Bay."

Amend said Amendment by inserting before the first paragraph the following:

'Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT to Authorize the Board of Environmental Protection to Regulate the Anchorage of Vessels in Maine Waters.'

Further amend said amendment by inserting at the beginning of the first line of the first paragraph the following: 'Further'

Further amend said amendment by striking out all of paragraph A of subsection 2 of that part designated "§560" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A. Anchorage. As used in this section, the word

"anchorage" means the mooring for a period of definite

or indefinite duration of a vessel designed or used to

carry oil, which is not waiting for a scheduled loading

or unloading of cargo in Maine waters, but shall not include

the mooring of a vessel for bunkering, maintenance, repair

or overhaul, or in connection with or as a part of sea

trials.'

Further amend said amendment by inserting in subsection 6 of that part designated "§560." after the word "waters" the following: 'for more than 7 days'

Further amend said amendment by inserting before the underlined words "and provide such information" in the 3rd line of subsection 8 of that part designated "§560." the following:

'and, shall cause public notice of the application and a brief summary to be published in a paper of general circulation in the vicinity of the proposed activity'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts certain necessary vessel activities from board regulation and clarifies the title.
