HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1725, L.D. 1939, Bill,
"AN ACT to Reform the State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill in section 66 by striking out all of the
3rd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sections 41, 44, 46 and 50 shall only apply to all
retirement allowances of law enforcement officers employed on
or after January 1, 1976. All retirement allowances of law
enforcement officers employed before January 1, 1976, shall
be determined under the provisions of Title 5, section 1121,
as in effect immediately prior to January 1, 1976. '

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to continue all members
in service prior to January 1, 1976 under the provision basing
retirement benefits on current annual salary rather than average
final salary.
