HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1725, L.D. 1939, Bill, "AN ACT to Reform the State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill in section 37 by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'This subsection shall only apply to a member who begins service prior to January 1, 1976, and who makes the single payment deposit or increased rate of contributions as required herein prior to January 1, 1976, or within 30 days of first becoming eligible to purchase such service, if this date is later than January 1, 1976.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow members currently in service, but not yet eligible to purchase parochial and private school teaching credits, to purchase such credits after January 1, 1976, if they do so within 30 days of attaining eligibility.
