HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to H.P. 1725, L.D. 1939, Bill, "AN ACT to Reform the State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 38 the following: 'Sec. 38-A. 5 MRSA §1094, sub-§16 is enacted to read:

16. Accumulated or accrued vacation or sick leave. All accumulated or accrued sick leave or unused vacation leave for which the member is credited on termination of service, but for which the member does not receive payment, shall be credited as membership service.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include as creditable service all time credited to a member for accumulated or accrued ick leave or vacation time, but for which he does not receive payment.
