HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 1725, L.D. 1939, Bill,
"AN ACT to Reform the State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill in section 45 by striking out in the 5th and 6th lines after the amending clause (same in L.D.) the words and punctuation "who was his spouse at the time of his retirement and inserting in place thereof the following stricken out words and punctuation: 'who-was-his-spouse-at-the-time-of-his
Fetirement'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to strike out the provision wherein the recipient has to be a spouse at the time of the member's retirement in order to receive his retirement allowance.
