AN ACT to Increase the Penalty for Littering.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17 MRSA § 2265, 3rd ¶, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 405, § 1, is amended to read:

The fine for violation of this section shall not be more than ~~\$100~~ \$250 for each offense and in addition thereto, in the sound discretion of any court in which conviction is obtained, such person may be directed by the judge to pick up and remove from any place any or all litter deposited thereon by anyone prior to the date of execution of sentence.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the maximum penalty for littering from \$100 to \$250.
