

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1758, L. D. 1944, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Uniform Standards for the Measurement of Wood."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the Enacting Clause the following:

'<u>Emergency preamble</u>. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is the purpose of this bill to ensure that harvesters of wood receive equitable measurement of their wood when it is sold; and

Whereas, most of the wood harvested in Maine is harvested and sold during the summer months; and

Whereas, it is therefore imperative that a standardized scale be established to govern sales of harvested wood as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the Bill.
