STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections to Lease Land in Augusta to the Maine Department of the American Legion.

Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections; authorized to lease land.
Resolved: That the Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections, in the name of the State of Maine, is authorized to enter into a 99-year lease for nominal consideration with the Maine Department of the American Legion for the purpose of construction and operation of a state headquarters and administrative center to be managed so as to provide assistance to its membership and to all veterans and their dependents in Maine in the areas of veterans benefits, community service projects and all of the patriotic and civil programs that the American Legion fosters on a certain lot or parcel of land situated in Augusta in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine being more particularly described as follows:

Starting on land, owned by the State of Maine, at a point on the westerly side of Hospital Street at the northeasterly corner of land being utilized by the Augusta Mental Health Institute of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections and the southeasterly corner of land being utilized by the Department of Forestry and being delineated by a low stone wall, thence running in a general westerly direction along the line of said stone wall 200 feet to a point, thence southerly in a general southerly direction 200 feet to a point, thence in a general easterly direction 200 feet to Hospital Street, thence in a general northerly direction, 200 feet along the line of Hospital Street to the point of beginning, meaning and intending to describe a parcel 200 feet by 200 feet.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections to lease land in Augusta to the Maine Department of the American Legion.
