HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1784, L.D. 1948, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to General Fund Aid to Local School Units."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause
at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation
and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the emergency
clause the following:

'Sec. 2. Allocation of bonds authorized in private and
special laws 1973, chapter 136, section 3 as amended by public
laws 1973, chapter 783, section 50. Bonds authorized in private
and special laws, 1973, chapter 136, section 3, as amended by
public law, 1973, chapter 783, section 50 are allocated as
follows:
