HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.
621, L.D. 1953, Bill, "AN ACT Converting Plantation 21 into the
Town of Osborn."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the first
paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the word and figure
"Plantation 21" and inserting in place thereof the words
'Osborn Plantation'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections
1, 2, 3 and 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

Sec. 1. Town of Osborn, incorporated. Osborn Plantation,
with the inhabitants therein, is hereby incorporated into a town
by the name of Osborn. The inhabitants of said town are hereby
vested with the powers, privileges and immunities which the
inhabitants of towns within the State do or may enjoy. The
town hereby created shall take the effects belonging to Osborn
Plantation and shall also assume all the obligations thereof.'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out in the next to
the last line of the 3rd paragraph the word and figure "Plantation
21" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Osborn Plantation'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out in the 12th line
of the 4th paragraph the word and figure "Plantation 21" and
inserting in place thereof the words 'Osborn Plantation'

Further amend said Amendment in the last paragraph by striking out in the 2nd line the word and figure "Plantation 21" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Osborn Plantation'

The purpose of this amendment is to correct the name of Plantation 21 used in the original bill to be Osborn Plantation.
