AN ACT Relating to Monthly School Tax Payments by Municipal Treasurers
to the Treasurer of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 453, First ¶, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 272, § 38, is amended by adding after the 3rd sentence the following new sentence:

Any of said payments by a municipal treasurer for a municipality may be made by submission of a credit voucher to the Treasurer of State, the amount of the voucher to be offset against the amount allocated on a monthly basis to that municipality pursuant to Title 20, section 3713.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to permit municipal treasurers to submit a credit voucher instead of cash when they pay their monthly school tax payment. This procedure will reduce the necessity for temporary borrowing by municipalities for this purpose.
