RESOLVE, Authorizing and Directing the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands to Permit Great Northern Paper Company to Cut and Remove Wood from Township 6, Range 11, W.E.L.S.

The Director of the Bureau of Public Lands; authorized. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands is hereby authorized and directed to issue a stumpage permit to Great Northern Paper Company (a division of Great Northern Nekoosa Corporation) allowing said company to cut and remove 100,000 cords of fir and spruce wood from Township 6, Range 11, W.E.L.S., said company paying therefor \$8 per cord as stumpage for 25,000 cords, the remaining 75,000 cords to be removed free of any stumpage cost to said company.

Said permit shall expire on May 1, 1979.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve will permit Great Northern and the State to complete the agreement authorized by 1975 Resolve, chapter 3. The deed from Great Northern to the State specifically disclaimed the right to cut the aforesaid timber on Township 6, Range 11 so that Great Northern would be in compliance with the Internal Revenue Code.
