HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1805, L.D. 1964, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Location of State Liquor Stores."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the period at the end of the first sentence after the amending clause the following:
'or unless an existing state store is located within 3 miles of another state store or unless the net operating cost of an existing state store exceeds 15% of its gross revenue'

The purpose of this amendment is to establish additional guidelines for closing of liquor stores.
