SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1812, L.D. 1971, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Unexpended Funds for Highway Construction on
Indian Reservations at Pleasant Point and Peter Dana Point."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first 2 lines
after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'PL 1973, c. 277, §2, is amended by adding at the end the
following new sentences:'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of the first
paragraph after the enacting clause and before the emergency
clause the following underlined sentences:

'These funds are to be used for the completion of the roads
related to the housing projects for which the funds were intended.
Following the completion of the purpose of this Act any funds
which may be remaining shall lapse.'

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that the funds
are used for the completion of the roads related to the housing
projects.
