COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1819, L.D. 1977, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify Provisions for County Jail and District
Court Facilities in the County of Hancock."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. P&SL 1975, c. 76, first sentence, 3rd paragraph
from the end, is amended to read:

The county commissioners shall cause the preparation of the
required ballots on which they shall state the subject matter of
this Act in the following question: "Shall 'An Act to Authorize
Hancock County to Raise \$600,000 for Construction of a Detention
Center and a District Court Facility,' passed by the regular session
of the 107th Legislature and amended by the special session of the
107th Legislature, be accepted?"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to restore the referendum
provision included in the original Act and to change the
question to reflect this amendment.
