COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 624, L.D. 1978, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Animal Welfare."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 1
the following new subsection:

'7. Exemption. This section shall not apply to
vocational agricultural courses, Future Farmers of
America, school-sponsored 4-H clubs and similar school
activities where improved nutrition and good and proper
animal husbandry are the objectives.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt from the
provisions of section 1 of the bill the types of school
activities described in the amendment where improved
nutrition and good and proper animal husbandry are the
objectives.
