COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 637, L.D. 2012, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Insurance Coverage for Blind Persons."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'24-A MRSA §2159-A, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 255, is amended to read:

Any such insurer may exclude from policies covering persons who are blind the payment of benefits arising from losses that result-directly-from would not have occurred except for the fact that such person is blind.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow insurers to exclude from coverage losses that would not have occurred except for the fact that the insured is blind.
