in PART C
Amend said amendment by inserting/after section 20 the
following:

'Sec. 20-A. P&SL 1975, c. 78, §18, amended. That part
of P & S L 1975, c. 78, §18 under the caption PUBLIC PROTECTION -
DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY, CIVIL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS, AND VETERANS'
SERVICES is amended by adding the following new paragraph at the
end of "Services to Veterans" to read as follows:

Any unexpended balance in excess of \$60,782 remaining
June 30, 1976 shall lapse.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment insures that moneys in the Department of Defense
and Veterans Services will not lapse but will be carried forward to
be expended in accordance with the provisions of the current
appropriations bill.
