Amend said Bill in PART A under the caption "Educational  
and Cultural Services" by inserting at the end the following:

'Central Maine Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 20,550

Provides additional operating funds.  
Increases undedicated revenue \$20,550

Eastern Maine Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 22,900

Provides additional operating funds.  
Increases undedicated revenue \$22,900

Kennebec Valley Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 8,500

Provides additional operating funds.  
Increases undedicated revenue \$8,500

Northern Maine Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 23,200

Provides additional operating funds.  
Increases undedicated revenue \$23,200

Southern Maine Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 73,400

Provides additional operating funds.  
Increases undedicated revenue \$73,400

**Washington County Vocational Technical Institute**

**All Other 12,050**

Provides additional operating funds.  
Increases undedicated revenue \$12,050'

Further amend said Bill in PART A by adjusting in the last line the "TOTAL GENERAL FUND --PART A" to read correctly.
