SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1846, L.D 2015, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing State, Maine Maritime Academy and University of Maine Employees' Pay."

Amend said Amendment in "PART A" by striking out in that part designated "University of Maine" the first 4 lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'University of Maine

General Activities

All Other 900,000

Provides funds for employee salary
increase'

Further amend said Amendment in PART A in the last line relating to "TOTAL GENERAL FUND--PART A" by adjusting the total to read correctly

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this Amendment is to adjust appropriations from the General Fund to increase the amount appropriated for the University of Maine so that the State will provide 1/2 of the amount of money necessary to provide an \$11 a week pay increase for University employees. An \$11 a week increase for University employees would require \$1,800,000.

This Amendment also provides language to guarantee that the appropriation would be used for benefits for University employees.
