"AN ACT to Provide Adequate Funds for the Operation of a Bureau

Amend said Bill by striking out the entire emergency preamble.

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Defense and Veterans Services for the fiscal year 1976-1977 the sum of \$11,250. The breakdown is as follows:

1976-77

DEFENSE AND VETERANS SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF

Bureau of Veterans Services

Personal Services

\$11,250

This appropriation is to be used to fund authorized positions for a Bureau of Veterans Services Office in Aroostook County.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to appropriate \$11,250 for 1976-77 to fund authorized positions for the Veterans Services Office in Aroostook County. At present this office is not operating because of the lack of funds and Aroostook County veterans are not being adequately served.
