COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 641, L.D. 2030, Bill,
"AN ACT to Correct Certain Inequities in the Motor Vehicle Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the fiscal
note, ← the following:

'These provisions shall apply only to those semi-permanent
registration plates in force on the effective date of this Act.'

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that this
legislation shall be in effect only until December 31, 1979,
the expiration of the current long term plates and shall not apply
to any new long term plates applied for after the effective
date of this Act. This amendment also puts an emergency
clause on the bill that was left off on the original bill
by error.
