HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " TO HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1873,
L.D. 2031, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal and Replace the Present
School Finance Law."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last line
of subsection 7 of the 22nd paragraph and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'paragraphs C and E;'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the
last sentence of subparagraph (3) of the 26th paragraph
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Reimbursement for transportation operating costs shall be
limited to the estimated costs used in compiling the commissioner's
recommendation and adjusted by the Legislature in its establishment
of the basic education appropriation for this item or the actual
expenditures.'

Further amend said Amendment in subsection 10 of the
34th paragraph by striking out all of the first sentence and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the commissioner
shall reimburse any municipality for providing the transportation
of school children to and from schools other than public schools,
except such schools as are operated for profit in whole or in part.'
