HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1873,
L.D. 2031, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal and Replace the Present School
Finance Law."

Amend said Amendment in the Fiscal Note by striking out
all of item 8 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'8. Geographic isolation 300,000'

Further amend said Amendment in the Fiscal Note by striking
out all of item 10 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'10. Private school transportation (at 90%) 200,000'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allocate sufficient
funds to cover the statutory exposure under the geographic
isolation provision in the law. Estimated expenditure is
\$285,639. The appropriation level of \$200,000 for private
school transportation is estimated by the / ^{Commissioner} on Educational
and Cultural Services to be sufficient to meet statutory
obligations. The reimbursement in fiscal year 1976 for private
school transportation was \$162,000.
