Amend said amendment in that part designated "§1320.", subsection  
2 in the 3rd line from the end by striking out the underlined word  
"and"

Further amend said amendment in that part designated "§1320.",  
subsection 2 in the last line by inserting before the period the  
underlined words 'and expenditures caused by the criminal prosecution  
of any inmate of a state institution'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts expenditures caused by the criminal  
prosecution of any inmate of a state institution from being counted  
when the amount of county support for the Superior Court is  
determined.
