AN ACT Relating to Employment of Drug Inspectors by the State Board
of Pharmacy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 2852, first sentence, is amended to read:

The board shall be empowered to appoint and remove ~~subject to the Personnel Law a 2 drug inspector~~ inspectors to enforce this chapter and Title 22, chapter 551, subchapter II and chapter 557 and the rules and regulations of the board.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to enable the Board of Pharmacy to have 2 drug inspectors not subject to the Personnel Law.
