HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 651,  
Certain  
L.D. 2056, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify/Provisions in the Education  
Laws."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last  
sentence of the 24th paragraph and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'The tuition rate thus determined shall be adjusted by the  
average change in public secondary education costs for the  
2 years immediately prior to the school year for which the  
tuition is computed.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes from the bill the 6% ceiling  
on tuition increases for out-of-town pupils.
