HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S.P. 651, L.D. 2056, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain
Provisions in the Education Laws."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after the 21st paragraph
the following:

'Sec. 12-B. 20 MRSA §912, first ¶, last sentence, as
amended by PL 1967, c. 425, §19, is repealed and the following
enacted in place thereof:

The elementary school tuition rate shall be computed as follows:
Divide the total elementary operating costs of the unit for the
period July 1st to June 30th immediately prior to the school year
for which the tuition rate is computed by the average daily
membership of the unit for elementary pupils for the school year
immediately preceding the school year for which the tuition rate
is computed. Total elementary operating costs shall be the costs
as defined in section 3743, subsection 5, which are attributable
to a childhood educational program, as defined in section 859,
through grade 8. The maximum elementary school tuition rate shall
be the rate as computed or the tuition rate of the unit for the im-
mediately preceding school year plus 6%, whichever is less.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish the elementary
school tuition rate.
