HOUSE AMENDMENT "H " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S.P. 651, L.D. 2056, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Provisions
in the Education Laws."

Amend said Amendment in section 30-A in subsection 1
by striking out all of the 2nd sentence and inserting in
place thereof the following: 'To determine the maximum seating
capacity of a school bus, the total linear width of all
pupil seats in inches shall be divided by 13 and rounded down
to the nearest whole number.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to return to that method
of determination used by the Department of Educational and
Cultural Services for seating capacities on school buses prior
to the Attorney General's opinion of December 11, 1975.
