
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
S.P. 651, L.D. 2056, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain  
Provisions in the Education Laws."

Amend said Amendment in section 29-H by striking out  
all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'In no event shall a local unit be responsible for contracted  
special education tuition and board in an amount greater than  
\$500 per pupil for any pupil for whom the unit has contracted.  
Any amount exceeding \$500 per pupil for any pupil shall be  
entirely reimbursed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that the  
\$500 per pupil limitation on the local unit's contribution  
to special education tuition and board costs applies to each  
pupil and not to the average costs of all such pupils.
